Middle School Uniform Guidelines

The College uniform is expected to be worn with pride and care. To ensure this happens:

- The Uniform Guidelines apply during school hours, while travelling to and from HGC, and when students are on College excursions;
- Students are expected to dress neatly and in the correct College uniform according to the season; Terms 1&4 Summer Uniform, Terms 2&3 Winter Uniform;
- Primary School Wear (PSW) are the current uniform supplier and order forms are available from the office or online (www.psw.com.au);
- All Hazel Glen College uniform items (except the summer dress, College grey shorts/pants, tunic skirt and socks/tights) have the College logo;
- All uniform items must be clearly labelled with the students name;
- Jewellery: The only acceptable jewellery items are; watches and small stud earrings / sleepers worn in the ears only (one in each ear);
- Extreme and unnatural hair colours or rinses and/or extreme hairstyles (e.g. spikes or shaved head patterns) are **not** permitted. If in the College's opinion it is unacceptable, it may result in the student's exclusion until the matter is satisfactorily resolved;
- Long hair should be kept neat, off the face and tied back for health and safety reasons; in accordance to our Head Lice Management Policy;
- All hair accessories should conform to the College colours (purple, black or white);
- Nail polish and cosmetics may not be worn;
- The prescribed Hazel Glen bucket hat or cap must be worn during Term 1 and Term 4 to and from school and at all times when outside (i.e. lunch, recess, sport). Hats are not to be worn inside;
- College Council requires the Principal to be responsible for implementation of the Uniform Policy in a manner consistent with the Student Code of Conduct;
- Students not wearing the prescribed uniform will be issued an 'Out of School Uniform Pass';
- Tailored Long or Short Sleeve Shirts must be tucked in during Terms 2 & 3 (must also have logo);
- Parents seeking exemptions to the Dress Code due to religious beliefs, ethnic or cultural background, student disability, health condition or economic hardship must apply in writing to the Principal for consideration;

The official uniform is the winter uniform, and the College blazer is the official external garment for students in Years 7-12. The blazer is to be worn to and from school at all times except on hot afternoons, as determined and advised by the Head of School or Assistant Principal.

Note: Year 5 & 6 students can wear the sports spray jacket to and from school on both Sport/PE and non-sport/PE days. They are not to be worn inside.

Decisions as to the suitability of any uniform item is made by the Head of School in conjunction with an Assistant Principal or Principal.

FOOTWEAR

- On non-sport/PE days, **students** must wear black leather lace up school shoes. **Note: T-bars or black leather runners are not permitted.**



- On sport/PE days, students must wear supportive runners with a rubber sole. **Note: skate shoes / Vans / Converse and basketball hi-top shoes are NOT permitted.**
