FOOTWEAR	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On non-sport/PE days, students must wear black leather lace up school shoes with black laces. <b>Note:</b> T-Bars or black leather runners are not permitted.</li> </ul> <div data-bbox="204 1480 847 1653" style="text-align: center;">  </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On sport/PE days, students must wear supportive runners with a rubber sole. <b>Note:</b> Skate Shoes/Vans/Converse and Basketball hi-top shoes are <b>NOT</b> permitted.</li> </ul>	
ACCESSORIES	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• College Backpack</li> <li>• College Cap</li> <li>• College Beanie (when cold)</li> <li>• Black Scarf Only (no other colours permitted)</li> <li>• Hair accessories (e.g. hair ties, scrunchies, ribbons) must be College Colours (including religious headwear)</li> </ul>	

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The College uniform is expected to be worn with pride and care. To ensure this happens:

- The Uniform Guidelines apply during school hours, while travelling to and from Hazel Glen, and when students are on school events;
- Students are expected to dress neatly and in the correct college uniform according to the season: Summer Uniform in Terms 1 and 4 and Winter Uniform in Terms 2 and 3;
- Primary School Wear (PSW) are the current uniform supplier and order forms are available online ([www.psw.com.au](http://www.psw.com.au));
- All Hazel Glen College uniform items (except the summer dress, College grey shorts/pants, tunic skirt and socks/tights) have the College logo;
- All uniform items must be clearly labelled with the student's name;
- Jewellery: the only acceptable jewellery items are watches, small stud earrings/sleepers worn in the ears only (1 in each ear) and nose piercings must be a small stud/clear discreet keeper;
- Extreme hair colours (e.g. green or purple) and/or extreme hair styles (e.g. spikes or shaved head patterns) are not permitted. If in the College opinion it is unacceptable, it may result in the student's exclusion until the matter is satisfactorily resolved;
- Long hair should be kept neat, off the face and tied back for health and safety reasons in accordance to our Head Lice Policy;
- All hair accessories should conform to the College colours (including religious headwear);
- Discreet cosmetics may be worn by students in Years 7-12. Only clear nail polish is permitted;
- The prescribed Hazel Glen hat must be worn during Term 1 and Term 4 and on any other day prescribed by the school. Hazel Glen College beanies with a logo may be worn in cold weather. Hats are not to be worn inside;
- College Council requires the Principal to be responsible for implementation of the Uniform Policy in a manner consistent with the Student Dress Code;
- Students not wearing the prescribed uniform will be issued an 'Out of School Uniform' notification that will be sent home to parents/guardians;
- Tailored Long or Short Sleeve Shirts with the College Logo must be tucked in;
- Parents seeking exemptions to the Dress Code due to religious beliefs, ethnic or cultural background, student disability, health condition or economic hardship must apply in writing to the Principal for consideration;

The official uniform is the winter uniform, and the College blazer is the official external garment for students in Years 7-12. The blazer is to be worn to and from school at all times except on hot afternoons, as determined and advised by the Head of School or Assistant Principal.

**Note:** Year 5 and 6 students can wear the sports jacket to and from school on both sport/PE and non-sport/PE days. They are not to be worn inside.

***Decisions as to the suitability of any uniform item is made by the Head of School in conjunction with an Assistant Principal.***
